

Morning Walking Session

On Thursday, June 3 from 6:15AM-7:30AM, MBT will be hosting a walking session where participants will be able to take MBTs for a fun fitness test walk on the streets of Baltimore prior to educational programming. The walk will be guided by MBT staff. MBT will have sample pairs of MBTs to offer for the participants to wear during the walk. Size and shoe availability is limited so it is on a first come basis. MBT staff will ensure proper fit prior to the participant's walk. The guided walk will be with the entire group (or groups based upon fitness levels) for 30-45 minutes throughout the surrounding area of Baltimore. The walking session will leave and return from a general area in front of the Hilton Baltimore. If there is rain, the fitting, instruction, start, and finish will all be held inside the Convention Center.
